



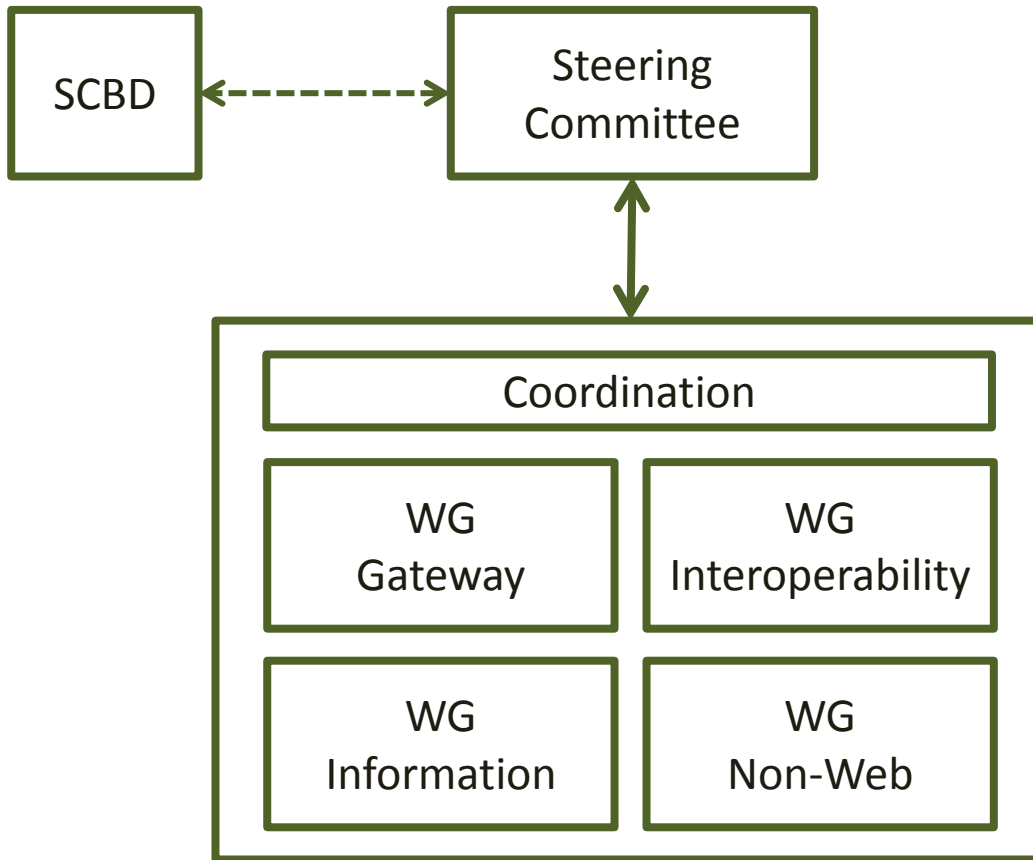

Operational structure



Coordination

- Outsourced to GBIF by the CBD Secretariat (10/2013 – 04-2014)
- Responsibilities
 - Serve as GIASIP focal point
 - Coordinate GIASIP with guidance from SC
 - Develop work plan with WG Chairs
 - Assist in developing 2014-20 Business Plan
 - Report against Operational Plan



Next steps 2013-2014

- Steering Committee
 - To be established during SBSTTA 17
 - Review and refine work plan
 - Establish priority deliverables
- Technical meeting for WG chairs
 - Plan population of gateway
 - Plan implementation
- Business Plan
 - Fundable model for GIASIP to 2020

- Tool for Target 9
 - Organise key data sets
 - Framework for information exchange
- GIASIP as a prototype for Target 19
 - Partnership for sharing information
 - Address Aichi Targets
 - Framework for engaging all stakeholders
 - Combined scientific and governmental oversight

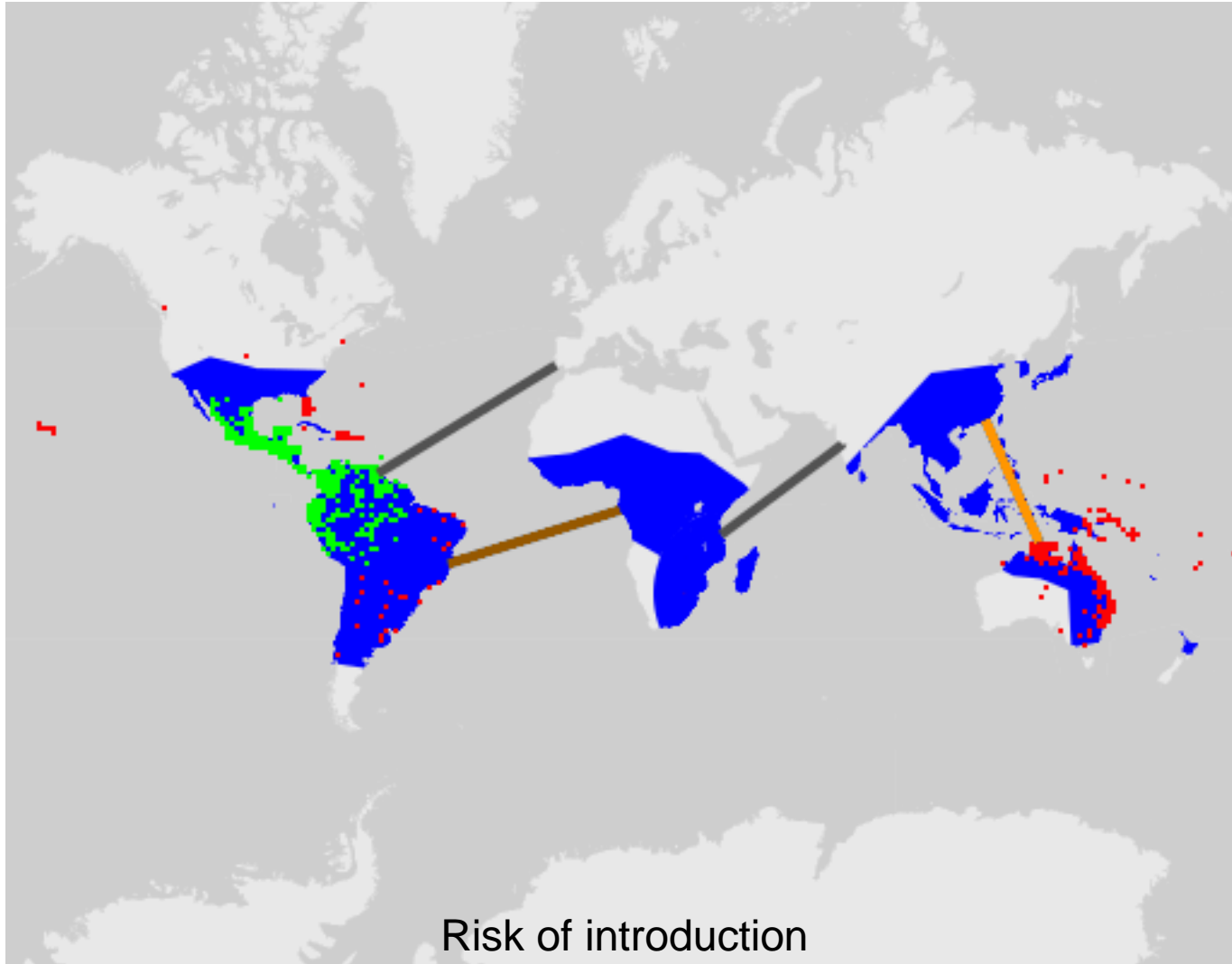


Broader engagement
